





He is a graduate of Modesto Junior College and San Jose State University with a B.A. in Art with a Painting Concentration. He is a past juror of many national and regional exhibitions including Watercolor West, Kentucky Watercolor Society, Utah Watercolor Society, Watercolor Society of Oregon, Red River Watermedia Show, Magnum Opus and many others.







He has been featured in The Artist's Magazine, Watercolor Magic, Watercolor Magazine, and Drawingboard Magazine. He has also been featured in several books including The Splash Series, Painting with the White of your Paper, The Transparent Watercolor Wheel and more. An active workshop instructor, Dale has traveled widely in both the U.S. and Abroad.
