You may enter any piece of art that you created in the last 3 years that has not WON a prize in one of our 3 annual judged shows. (people’s choice does not apply as a win). If you are not sure if you won a prize for the artwork, email me and I will check the programs for you.

GUIDELINES for Traditional Watermedia:

Entries are limited to Water Media including any combination of watercolor, tempera, gouache, opaque watercolor, acrylic, casein, ink, charcoal, gesso, watercolor crayons, pencils and pens including metallic. One must exclude water-soluble oils as well as any other similar substance. Acceptable surfaces for watercolor are substrates created for watermedia. For example: paper, clay coated surfaces (Clayboard, Aquaboard, Ampersand), synthetic surfaces, (Yupo, Tiger Rag), illustration board and flat watercolor canvas. Watercolor Collage is acceptable, but newspaper, magazine or non-watercolor material cutouts will not be accepted.

NOTE: I certify that this work is an original, not a copy of another artist’s work or a copy of any



photograph not taken by me. Work must be done by a single artist not a collaborative work and must have been completed within the last three years. Work that was done in a workshop can be entered provided that the work is based on the artists own original image and the instructor did not critique the work or otherwise suggest any changes to the painting. Tasteful nudes are allowed.

GUIDELINES for “Masterpiece Reimagined”

Pick a famous artist whether old masters, pop artist, impressionism etc. Add your own personal touch to reimagine it. Have fun with this!

Title your work: MR:Girl with a Pearl Earring (as an example). Put in the MR so we know it is a Masterpiece Reimagined.

Entries are limited to Water Media including any combination of watercolor, tempera, gouache, opaque watercolor, acrylic, casein, ink, charcoal, gesso, watercolor crayons, pencils and pens including metallic. One must exclude water-soluble oils as well as any other similar substance. Acceptable surfaces for watercolor are substrates created for watermedia. For example: paper, clay coated surfaces (Clayboard, Aquaboard, Ampersand), synthetic surfaces, (Yupo, Tiger Rag), illustration board and flat watercolor canvas. Watercolor Collage is acceptable, but newspaper, magazine or non-watercolor material cutouts will not be accepted.

Submission Guidelines: Artists may enter one or two paintings. A non-refundable fee of \$25 for GCWS members will be paid online at cloudfolios.com before you upload your artwork. No changes can be made after entry is received. No refunds will be made. BE SURE YOU ENTER ALL YOUR PIECES AT SAME TIME. GCWS is entitled to a 10% donation on the sale of all artwork during the exhibition. All entries must be made on-line at Cloudfolios.com. You must create a free Cloud Folios account and upload your images as a jpeg. For each piece of art you enter in our online show you will need: **TITLE, MEDIUM, PRICE, WIDTH AND HEIGHT**. Collect the data before you start entering your work at www.cloudfolios.com. Do not show any frame or mat and the image must be correctly oriented either vertical or horizontal. For best results, your images should be less than 2mb to upload quickly.
