# May Meeting: Critique of Member's Work by Eydi Lampasona and Nancy Neidich

#### Eydi Lampasona

Born to artist parents, Eydi grew up in south Florida surrounded by art. She is an interdisciplinary artist working in mixed-media painting, collage/assemblage and printmaking. She has received numerous national and international awards, exhibits in museums and galleries worldwide and conducts art workshops internationally.

Eydi has been published in six art books, including "The Painters Workshop, Composition and Design", "Acrylic Revolution", and "Rethinking Acrylics, Radical Solutions

for Exploiting the World's Most Versatile Medium, "The Art of Layering: Making Connections," and "Collage in all Dimensions" and the yet to be released "Creating Collage in all Dimensions II" She also has been featured in several national art magazines. Eydi is a signature member of the National Watercolor Society, National Collage Society, the International Society of Experimental Artists and the Society of Layerists in Multi-Media. Eydi's work is represented in public and corporate collections and is listed in Who's Who in American Art and Who's Who in America.

#### **Nancy Neidich**



Nancy has been fascinated by incongruous pieces of beauty found amongst chaos and linear proportion - of seemingly regular bits hidden in chaos. She wants people to look at her paintings and see that hidden thing, to find that spot, that draws them over to look more because there is something there that evokes a hidden memory or message. She would like the viewer to have a feeling of eureka, of having discovered something of themselves after reflecting on the painting. She has studied how random applications of paint and solvents can be drawn into cohesion. Her art reflects a certain natural conformance within the surrounding non-conformity or chaos. The addition of personal symbols help evoke something

to identify with – a touch to remind that all of life is chaotic but that natural forces (like gravity or evolution) impose some control on the chaos.

Nancy is a signature member of Gold Coast Watercolor Society, National Collage Society and International Society of Experimental Artists and has won numerous awards both locally and nationally, particularly with her mixed media collage "Lost Dress" series.




# Carol's Corner by Carol Thaw
